

ADDRESSING TRAUMA IN ROSEN METHOD BODYWORK

A RESIDENTIAL INTENSIVE WITH SARAH DANDRIDGE AND MAJA SKAU-OLSEN



This Rosen Method bodywork intensive will focus on the qualities of Rosen Method bodywork that support a client when working with traumatic material. What is trauma? How do we recognize if someone is traumatized? What do Rosen students need to know to work with clients who have trauma? Is Rosen Method appropriate for all kinds of trauma and for all people with trauma? Together we will explore these questions.

This intensive will provide a basic understanding of trauma and ways that Rosen Method can address trauma. Participants will explore states of the nervous system that indicate trauma, such as dissociation, freeze, hyperarousal, hypervigilance. We will observe and experience these states in our bodies and how we can work with them as a Rosen Method practitioner. We will focus on the skill of “tracking”: the ability to follow a client’s process and address what is happening in the moment. As in all Rosen Method intensives, there will be sharing circles, exercises, teaching and table work.

Sarah Dandridge and Maja Skau-Olsen have extensive personal and professional experience with trauma. They are looking forward to sharing their knowledge and experience from a Rosen Method perspective.

Deborah Marks, certified trainer of Rosen movement teachers and senior bodywork teacher, will support participants to become more embodied, more relaxed, and more alive. She brings an integrated embodiment of the link between movement and bodywork, illustrating how both of them enhance consciousness and self-awareness.

DEBORAH MARKS, USA

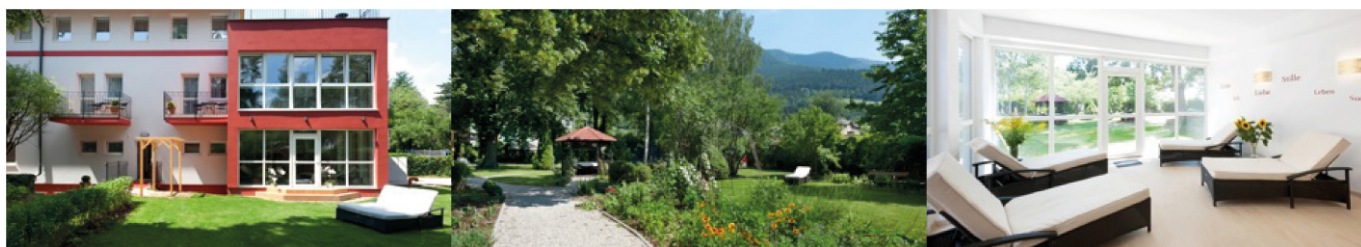
Rosen Movement Teacher Trainer and Senior Bodywork Teacher
